Feast and Follies - September 24th

Music in the Middle School Concerts - October 3 & 4, 2016

Held at Grimsley High School, volunteers assist in staging a concert by the Greensboro Symphony Orchestra for seventh grade students. Guild volunteers are needed to direct the children from their buses to their seats and in exiting. This activity is about a 4 hour morning time commitment. It's a great way to meet other Guild members in a smaller setting. We usually need about 25 volunteers for each day.
